This program is for current medical assistants without certification or clinical partners with 6+ months of current direct patient care experience in a healthcare setting. Students will learn the skills necessary to function safely and efficiently in a medical office setting, including both administrative and clinical duties. Students will be prepared for and take the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant exam for certification with the National Healthcareer Association.

Selection for the CCMA Bridge Program will be completed by STLCC and BJC Medical Group leadership. Qualified individuals must meet the eligibility requirements below to be considered.

- Have 1+ years of employment with BJC HealthCare (by December 1, 2021) and be in good standing
- Have 6+ months current experience in a direct patient care role
- Complete and submit the BJC HealthCare interest questionnaire
- Complete all intake steps for the STLCC Healthcare Workforce Training (HWT) program
 - Includes application and assessments: WorkKeys, HCRA (Fit Assessment), and Medical Assistant Competency Exam
- Submit a letter of recommendation from your current leader

- Apply generic health knowledge and perform basic patient care skills.
- Demonstrate safe practices while caring for patients.
- Assist with medical examination, assessment and procedures.
